Who are we?

Save the School Foundation is a UK registered non-profitable charity organisation which was established back in 2008. [Registration no:7331618]





What do we do?

- We are focused on making a long- term impact by helping under privileged children living in poverty in rural parts of the world. Education combats poverty- Provide quality education and you are capable of changing the world, one school at a time.
- We have bold vision: **Quality education for a better world.**





Ongoing projects/commitments

- Improving education quality by replacing **over 500** worn out blackboards (from 57 different schools) with new white boards.







School supplies – We have provided various schools with computers/ printers /projectors/ laminators. Things like this are necessity in the UK but in rural parts of the world these are identified as being highly privileged.

Anyone here who can imagine what is life like without a computer????









Ongoing projects/commitments

Library initiation: We are currently supporting few schools to set up their own library to help more students discover the joy and value of reading.







Classroom supplies: We are currently sponsoring over 600 students (from 15 different schools) who are aged between 5-8 years with unlimited access to stationeries such books, pen, pencils, erasers, sharpeners and art & crafts.

This has been going on for almost 10 years (Yes- since 2008 when we established Save the School Foundation!)

- Penny for Penny project- Myself and Ms Carolyn Green (member of Science Department) had started this initiative at this very place (Yes- Thomas Tallis) back in 2008. We started collecting every penny from the floor (that people had thrown away) and by today, the project has helped us support over 70 schools in different ways.
